 SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS**

1. Druidale Motor club will organise a Clubman Production Car Autotest on the following dates and at the following venues:

2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of Motorsport UK, (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

3. The following permits have been issued:

4. The event is open to fully elected members of Druidale Motor club. Competitors requiring membership must indicate this on their entry form.
5. Competitors must hold a valid 2020 Motorsport UK Competition Licence, the minimum being an RS Clubman Licence. The RS Clubman Licence is free of charge and must be applied for in advance of the event. Competitors can apply for an RS Clubman via <https://www.motorsportuk.org/get-started/2020-rs-clubman-licence/>.
6. The programme of the meeting will be:

Scrutineering:	09:00hrs
Signing on:	09:00hrs (Any competitor not signed on by 10:15hrs may be disqualified.)
First test starts:	10:00hrs
Event due to finish:	16:00hrs

Scrutineering / Signing on / Documentation:

Due to current MSUK Covid- 19 guidance, all competitors who wish to take part in the event need to complete and upload to the entries system no later than 3 days before the event a FULLY completed Pre-Event Declaration RS Clubman which can be located via the entries system. Licences and membership card will not be physically checked and Ad-Hoc verification will be carried out by Motorsport UK.

Attendance at the event is only permitted if competitors are well and NOT exhibiting any Covid-19 symptoms.

7. All cars must be in a good condition, they will be seen by a scrutineer on the day who's decision will be final.
8. Classes for the event(s) will be as follows:

1	FWD up to 1000cc
2	FWD 1001cc up to 1600cc

3	FWD over 1600cc
4	RWD Production
5	Specials / Modified Cars / 4WD Cars or none standard slip differential
6	Juniors – up to 18 years (Parent/Guardian Required if Driver does not hold a valid Driving Licence)

Modified will not mean removing bumpers or seats, or making any other “cosmetic” alterations, but will mean, modifying the engine, gearbox or axle to improve engine performance or traction. Induction modification are free. Adding a sump guard, roll cage, full harness or any other safety accessory will not be deemed, in the spirit of the above description, as a “modification”.

Please note cars must be entered into the appropriate class. For example, unmodified FWD drive cars up to 1500cc, must enter Class 1. Only specials, modified cars, 4 wheel drive or cars with limited slip differentials, untaxed, may enter Class 5. Tyres must be road specification pattern. No M/S, A/T or off road tyres permitted.

Car sharing will be permitted in accordance with Section M of the Motorsport UK Yearbook.

9. Awards: 1st / 2nd / 3rd Overall
10. The entry list opens on receipt of these regulations and close finally as indicated below. Entries must be made on the electronic entry form via Rallies.Info and will be accepted in order of receipt. **No entries will be accepted on the day.**

The entry fee for each event is **£30.00**. Entries must be paid via online transfer only and received no later than the date indicated above. Failure to make payment will result in your entry being removed.

The maximum entry for the meeting including reserves is 30. The minimum is 15. Should the minimum entry figure not be reached the organisers reserve the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes. Entry fees may be refunded at the organisers’ discretion.

12. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event and will be posted on the Druidale Motor Club Website / Facebook Page.
13. Any protests must be lodged in accordance with Motorsport UK regulations Section C.
14. General rule:
 - Details of tests will be available at signing on.
 - Timing will be Electronic. LCD stopwatches will be used in the event of equipment failure.
 - All competitors will have the opportunity to walk each test layout before timed runs start for that course.
 - Each driver will have two or more runs at each test layout. The number of predicated runs will be announced on the day; runs are dependent on weather conditions and delays on the day.
 - Competitors will start in their own time upon clearance from the timekeeper. Timing will start when the front wheels cross the timing line. Timing will stop when the front wheels cross the flying finish line. The car must stop astride the stop line if further penalty is not to be incurred.
 - In the event of a tie the fastest run on the first course will determine the tie, and then the fastest on the second course etc, until the tie is resolved. To be classified as a finisher , competitors must start at least one test on each course or as per Motorsport UK General Regulations.
15. Penalties will be in accordance with Motorsport UK General Regulations M.7
